**Allahu Akbar Allahu Akbar
La ilaaha ilaallahu Wallahu Akbar
Allahu Akbar Wa Lillaahil Hamd.**

From the *Fajr* of the ninth (9th) of Dhul-Hijja to the *Asr* of the thirteenth (13th) Dhul-Hijja¹ it is *Wajib* for men to recite the above Takbeer aloud three times immediately after every Fard Namaaz. Women are required to recite softly.

¹ Some minority holds the view that these Takbiraat starts from 8th Dhul-Hijja *Maghrib* (any new Islamic calendar day or month start with *Maghrib*) [which is the beginning of the day of *Arafah*]. There's no difference in ending of Takbeerat as *Asr* is end of the day time. Technically speaking, this opinion is sound. *Wallahu Alam*.
